- 2. The Xiangtan Finance Bureau ("the Purchaser") invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for Development, Provision Installation and Commissioning of the Smart City-wide ICT Platform Operation System (the "Goods").
- Open Competitive Bidding (international advertisement) will be conducted in accordance with ADB's <u>Single-Stage: One-Envelope</u> procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
- 4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications defined in the Bidding Document may participate in this bidding:
 - a. Nonperformance of a contract did not occur as a result of contractor default since September 1, 2020
 - b. All pending litigation and arbitration, if any, shall be treated as resolved against the Bidder and shall not represent a total of more than fifty percent (50%) of the Bidder's net worth calculated as the difference between total assets and total liabilities.
 - c. From 1 January 2019 to the bid submission deadline, successful completion as main supplier of at least two (2) contracts, each valued at no less than **CNY 54 million** or its equivalent in other currency, related to any business direction of information construction.
 - d. Submission of audited financial statements or, if not required by the law of the Bidder's country, other financial statements acceptable to the Purchaser, for the last **three (3) years** (Year 2021-2023) to demonstrate the current soundness of the Bidder's financial position. The bidder's net worth for last year calculated as the difference between total assets and total liabilities should be positive as a minimum requirement.
 - e. Minimum average annual turnover of **CNY 134 million** or its equivalent in other currency calculated as total payments received by the Bidder for contracts completed or under execution over the last **three (3) years**.
 - f. Availability of or access to liquid assets, lines of credit, and other finances sufficient to meet the cash flow requirement of **CNY 34 million** or its equivalent in other currency.

The qualification criteria are more completely described in the Bidding Document.
